

Class 1: Introduction to Spoken English

Greetings and introductions

- How to greet people in different situations, such as formal and informal settings
- How to introduce yourself and others
- Common phrases for greetings and introductions

Simple sentence structure

- Forming basic subject-verb-object sentences
- Using different verb tenses (present, past, and future)
- Constructing questions and negatives

Class 2: Everyday Conversations

Asking and answering questions

- Forming different types of questions (wh-questions, yes/no questions)
- Using question words (who, what, where, when, why, how)
- Responding to questions appropriately

Expressing opinions and preferences

- Using phrases to express opinions (I think, I believe, I feel)
- Making comparisons and contrasts
- Agreeing and disagreeing politely

Class 3: Making Friends and Socializing

Making introductions and small talk

- Initiating conversations and making introductions
- Finding common interests and making connections
- Maintaining conversations with polite and engaging topics

Talking about hobbies and interests

- Discussing leisure activities and hobbies
- Sharing experiences and opinions about hobbies
- Recommending activities and places to visit

Inviting friends to events

- Using appropriate language for invitations
- Providing details about the event (date, time, location)
- Expressing interest in attending events

Class 4: Family, Relationships and Celebrations

Talking about family members

- Describing family members and their relationships
- Sharing anecdotes and stories about family life
- Expressing love and appreciation for family

Describing relationships

- Talking about different types of relationships
- Discussing the qualities and importance of good relationships
- Expressing emotions and feelings related to relationships

Discussing family traditions and celebrations

- Sharing cultural traditions and family customs
- Describing holiday celebrations and special occasions
- Exchanging gifts and expressing gratitude

Class 5: Work and Education

Talking about jobs and professions

- Describing different types of jobs and careers
- Using vocabulary related to work and employment
- Sharing experiences and aspirations related to work

***Asking about education and qualifications**

- Inquiring about educational background and qualifications
- Discussing academic achievements and areas of expertise
- Sharing opinions about education and its importance

Describing work experience

- Talking about previous work experiences and responsibilities
- Highlighting skills and accomplishments gained from work
- Discussing career goals and aspirations

Class 6 Entertainment and Leisure

Talking about movies, books, and music

- Discussing favorite movies, books, and music genres
- Sharing opinions and recommendations about entertainment
- Engaging in conversations about plots, characters, and themes

Planning leisure activities

- Discussing leisure interests and preferences
- Organizing activities with friends and family
- Making reservations and arrangements for leisure activities

Discussing sports and hobbies

- Talking about favorite sports teams and athletes
- Sharing experiences and knowledge about sports
- Discussing hobbies and personal interests

Class 7: Food and Shopping

Ordering food and drinks

- Using restaurant vocabulary (menu, appetizer, main course, dessert)
- Placing orders with a waiter or waitress
- Making polite requests and expressing preferences

Describing food and drinks

- Using adjectives to describe food and drinks
- Talking about tastes, textures, and flavors
- Sharing opinions about different cuisines

Shopping for groceries and clothes

- Shopping vocabulary (groceries, clothes, store, aisle, cashier)
- Asking for and finding items in a store
- Making purchases and paying for goods

Class 8: Technology and Social Media

Talking about computers and the internet

- Discussing basic computer functions and terminology
- Understanding common internet terms and applications
- Using technology for communication and information gathering

Using social media platforms

- Creating and managing social media accounts
- Sharing content and interacting with others on social media
- Understanding the etiquette and safety of social media

Discussing the impact of technology on society

- Exploring the positive and negative effects of technology
- Discussing the impact of technology on communication, work, and culture
- Considering the future of technology and its impact on society

Class 9: Numbers and Money

Counting numbers

- Counting numbers from 1 to 100 and beyond
- Using ordinal numbers (first, second, third, etc.)

- Counting money and prices

Telling time

- Understanding the concept of time and telling time on a clock
- Using phrases to express time (o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to)
- Discussing daily schedules and routines

Talking about money and prices

- Counting and exchanging money
- Understanding different currencies and exchange rates
- Discussing prices and making purchases

Class 10: Travel and Directions

Asking and giving directions

- Using compass directions (north, south, east, west)
- Giving directions using landmarks and street names
- Asking for directions politely

Booking transportation tickets

- Understanding different types of transportation (plane, train, bus)
- Booking tickets online or in person
- Asking about schedules and fares

Checking in at a hotel

- Hotel vocabulary (reception, check-in, check-out, room, key)
- Checking in with the receptionist
- Asking about hotel amenities and facilities

Class 11: Health and Wellness

Talking about symptoms and illnesses

- Describing symptoms and health concerns using appropriate vocabulary
- Explaining the severity and duration of symptoms
- Seeking medical advice and treatment options

Asking for and giving medical advice

- Asking questions about symptoms and medical history
- Providing suggestions and recommendations for treatment
- Encouraging healthy habits and preventive measures

Making appointments with doctors and dentists

- Scheduling appointments by phone or online
- Providing necessary information for appointments
- Confirming appointment details and reminders

Class 12: Review and Wrap-Up

Review of key grammar concepts and vocabulary

- Revisiting essential grammar rules and structures
- Expanding vocabulary and practicing using new words
- Engaging in interactive exercises to reinforce learning

Practice speaking in different situations

- Role-playing real-life scenarios to apply spoken English
- Participating in group discussions and debates
- Delivering short presentations and speeches

Reflect on progress and set goals for continued learning

- Evaluating personal growth and achievements in spoken English
- Identifying areas for improvement and setting goals for further learning
